- 1. Complete the SJUSD Counseling Internship Interest Form at http://go.sjusd.org/ACintern. Our Academic Counselors will have access to this and will contact you directly to schedule an interview. Please note that internships are not guaranteed as they are based on student need and school availability. At this time we are only accepting SJSU EDCO interns. Please contact Esmeralda Navarro if you are interested in participating from another program (esnavarro@sjusd.org).
- 2. Complete the SJUSD Volunteer Application at: http://go.sjusd.org/volunteer. In the "School/ Dept" drop down select "District Office."
- 3. **Schedule you fingerprint appointment**. You will receive the link to do so after submitting the above application. For the last field, "School Site / Location," put "AC Intern." This will allow us to wave the fingerprinting fees.
- 4. On the day of your fingerprint appointment, please be sure to bring the following:
 - Tuberculosis clearance, no more than 60 days old from the time of the fingerprint appointment
 - Valid Driver's License or ID card
