- 1) Email Diana Carty with resume (<u>dcarty@musd.org</u>) and a couple of dates/times you'd be available for a 15 minute phone call.
- 2) After phone call, set up an in-person interview and campus tour (will take approximately 1 hour total).
 - a) Interview: Share about yourself, learn about the projects you could be working on at Cal Hills, ask any questions you have about the school.
 - b) Campus Tour: Meet some staff and students, review bell schedule, general campus policies
