


MySJSU Account Activation

MySJSU is the official communication tool during a students admission and enrollment process at San Jose State University. Please remind your students who applied to SJSU to activate their MySJSU account to check important messages and **"To Do List"** items.

Students can also view their admissions status through their MySJSU account. After students create their MySJSU account they can log in to <u>one.sjsu.edu</u> then click on **Self Service** title, next, **Student Center**, and **Application Status**.

After students submit their first application to a CSU campus they will not be able to make any changes to the application. If they need to make any corrections or updates, students will need to <u>contact the campuses</u> they applied to individually.

The deadline for the FAFSA and CADAA is **April 2, 2024**. Please encourage students to submit by **March 2, 2024** especially if they applied to a CSU campus.
