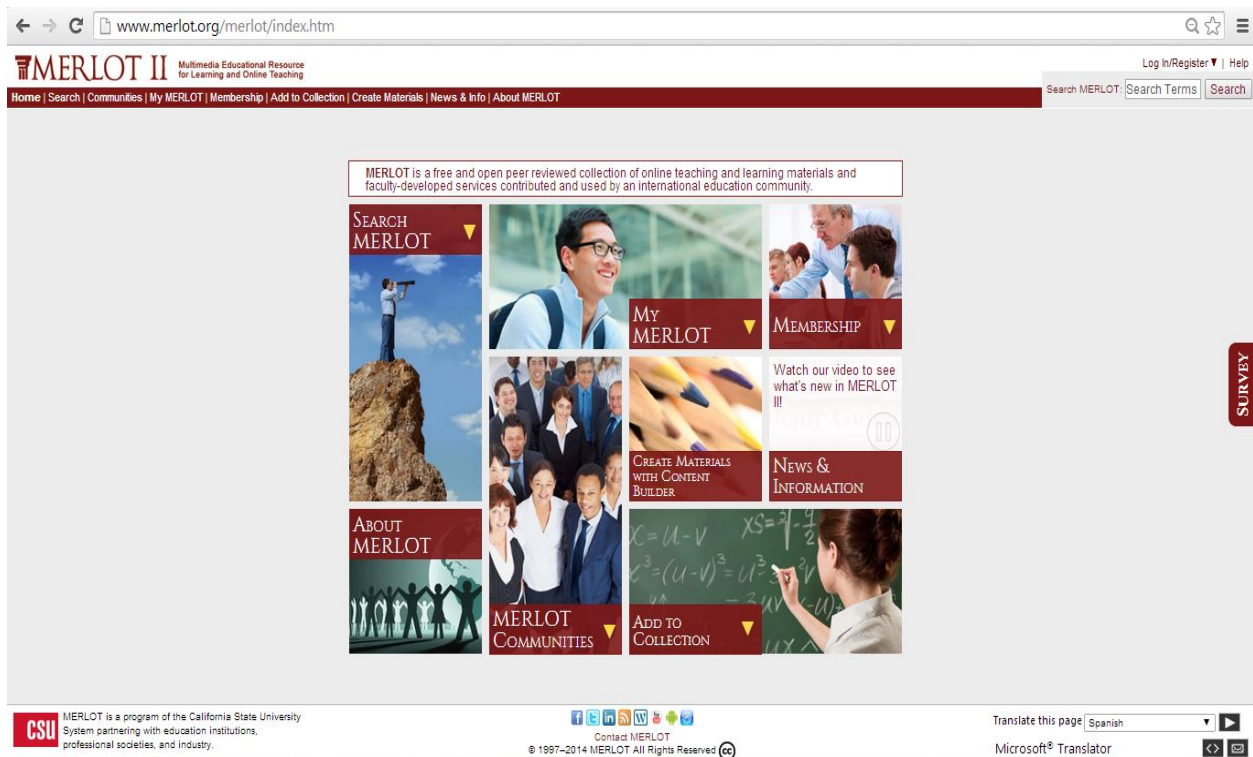


MERLOT
