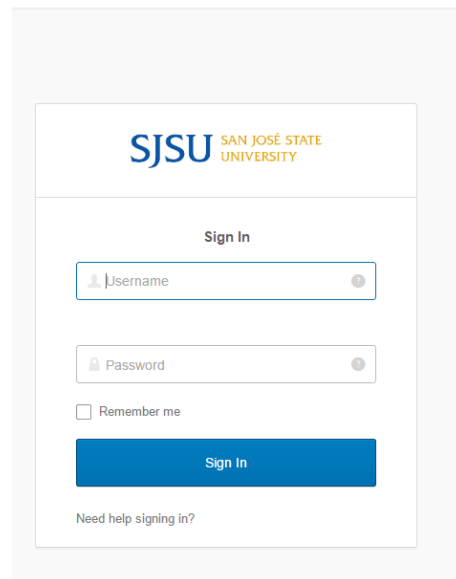

SJSUOne ID and Password FAQ

SJSUOne is a password consolidation system. An SJSUOne account is a university access account available to all current faculty, staff and students at San José State.

You can use your SJSUOne ID and password to log in to most SJSU applications on campus, including the SJSU wireless network, SJSU email and MySJSU.

I am a first-time user

- **Open University Students:** On the first day of late registration, we post an Open University Quick Admit login button on the MySJSU homepage. Click this login button to register and get a system generated ID and password.
Note: Activation of your [SJSUOne](#) account is optional.
- **New Matriculated Students and New Employees:** As a first time user, you must create a password before you can log in. Accounts have been created for all current faculty, staff and students. Your SJSUOne account is automatically created and removed based on MySJSU records.
