Dr. Rangapriya (Priya) Kannan

Dr. Rangapriya (Priya) Kannan is dean of the Lucas College and Graduate School of Business. Kannan is a first-generation immigrant and is the first woman and the first person from India to lead the Lucas College and Graduate School of Business on a permanent basis as dean.

Kannan joins SJSU from the University of San Diego, where she was the associate dean of faculty and accreditation and a professor of strategic management, innovation and entrepreneurship. She also serves as a research professor of entrepreneurship at University of Exeter Business School, one of the UK's leading institutions. Prior to her role as Associate Dean, Dr. Kannan was the inaugural chairperson of the i3 department that houses Innovation and Entrepreneurship, International Business, and Interdisciplinary Studies at the Knauss School of Business. She was also the founding director of the Entrepreneurship and Innovation Catalyzer (The CatalyZer).

Dr. Kannan earned a PhD from the UCLA Anderson School of Management. She earned her Masters in Industrial/ Organizational Psychology from SJSU and was recognized as a Sally Casanova Scholar. Additionally, she has earned a Masters in Personnel Management & Industrial Relations from Tata Institute of Social Sciences (India), and is a graduate of the Cost and Works Accountants Society (India). Her undergraduate studies were completed at the University of Bombay (India), where she received a Bachelor of Commerce degree.





Bob Curley

Bob Curley is the Division CEO of Bridge Bank, a division of Western Alliance Bank, Member FDIC, and the Chief Deputy Banking Officer - Regional Banking where he assumes additional oversight for several of the banks national business lines.

Mr. Curley has over 30 years of experience in technology lending, investment banking, venture debt and equity financing. Based in San Jose, he and his teams serve clients throughout the United States.

Dinesh Nirmal

Dinesh Nirmal, Senior Vice President, leads products for IBM Software. He is responsible for new products and innovation, the company's software product and technology direction, location strategy, support and ecosystem development.

Dinesh has spent more than 25 years at IBM. Previously, he was General Manager for Data, Al and Automation at IBM, responsible for driving the business strategy, technology development, operations, sales and marketing, and overall financial performance for IBM's Data, Al and Automation Software portfolio. Under his leadership, Dinesh further strengthened IBM's hybrid cloud and AI capabilities through the acquisition of several market-leading companie.

He has held several other leadership roles at IBM, including Vice President of Development for IBM Data and Al. An international event speaker and writer, Dinesh has participated in tech industry events and conferences. Dinesh was honored in the 2022 Ascend A-List awards. He also serves on the Board of R Consortium to help guide the open-source R language and is an advisor for Accel.Al.

Christopher Thornberg

Dr. Christopher Thornberg has been called many things throughout his career, but his favorite thing to be called is correct. A renowned economist with deep expertise in economic and revenue forecasting, regional economics, eco-nomic policy, and labor and real estate markets, Dr. Thornberg has consulted globally for private industry, cities, counties, and public agencies. He founded Beacon Economics LLC in 2006 and under his leadership the firm has become one of the most respected research organizations in California.

Dr. Thornberg became nationally known for forecasting the subprime mort-gage market crash that began in 2007 and was one of the few economists on record to predict the global economic recession that followed. Amidst the 2020 Covid-19 shock, Dr Thornberg correctly predicted the rapid "V" shaped economic recovery, the inflation that resulted from excessive government stimulus, as well as the sharp hikes in interest and mortgage rates currently impacting U.S. markets.

Dr. Thornberg's trusted commentary and his evidence-based approach to economic policy analysis has built a legacy of correct calls and an ecosystem that includes some of the world's most influential entities. Regardless of the audience, client, or project, Dr. Thornberg holds firmly to the principle of ob-jective economic analysis, often saying that 'you can pay for analysis, but you might not like the answers the data uncovers.'




Jay Ross
