2. EOP PAGES

All EOP students must attend and complete three (3) SJSU campus/center events (in-person or virtual) AND then submit three (3) EOP Fall 2024 PAGES Surveys this semester by the deadline: FRIDAY, 12/6/24

Complete one (1) event in each of the following categories:

- **Professional:** SJSU Career Center sponsored events, fairs, online tutorials, and other career success resources
- **Academic:** Peer Connections, Writing Center, MLK Library, and Study Abroad sponsored events
- **Personal:** events of your choosing that support your college experience; Weeks of Welcome, Spartan Speaker Series, LinkedIn Learning, Student Success units, and U-Thrive

NOTE: Departmental/Success Center or Major advising, drop-in advising, GE advising, tutoring, SJSU/EOP peer mentoring, Town Hall, student organization tabling events, concerts, or non-SJSU events do not fill this requirement. 3. EOP END OF SEMESTER SURVEY (EOS)

All EOP students will receive a message and link to the EOS in mid-November. The survey completion deadline is **FRIDAY, 12/6/24**.

- The EOS EOP is a brief assessment of current EOP events and services and is vital to planning for the next semester

EOP STUDENT SUCCESS ADVISING AND MENTORING

EOP students are strongly encouraged to check in with the [College Success Center](#) in their declared major for assistance with academic course requirements

- EOP will hold drop-in advising to assist with questions that you may have throughout the semester
- You may also email your assigned EOP advisor with specific questions
- Check-in with your College Success Center as needed to stay on track with academic requirements
- Peer Connections, Centro, and the BLOC are a few departments on campus that offer Peer Mentoring for students.

EOP ENGAGEMENT CHECK-IN

At the end of each semester of enrollment at SJSU, students who do not complete program requirements may receive an engagement check-in email. Students who do not meet EOP program requirements for the fall term will have their EOP status reevaluated at the end of the academic year (spring term) and may be removed from the program at that time to make space for incoming students.
