

Ed.D Leadership Program

Admit Term: Summer 2023

How to Apply: File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2022-2023 academic year at www.studentaid.gov. Your eligibility for aid programs is based on your EFC (Expected Family Contribution).

The FAFSA must be completed each academic year to be considered for aid. *Admitted students for the Summer of 2023 must file the 2022-2023 FAFSA to be considered for financial aid.* Students enrolling Fall 2023, Spring 2024 and Summer 2024 must also file the 2023-2024 FAFSA. The school code for San Jose State University is 001155. After we receive your FAFSA data, you will need to complete your file by submitting the documents on your “To Do” list in your [MySJSU](#) account.

Apply Early! File the FAFSA ASAP. **Priority filing for grant consideration is April 1, 2023.** Your federal loan request cannot be processed until you have received a financial aid award notice. Keep your [MySJSU](#) account information current. All correspondence will be done through email and messaging through your MySJSU.edu account. **Deadline to apply for Summer Aid consideration is July 10, 2023.**

Types of Aid: Eligible students with demonstrated need may qualify to receive the **Ed.D Doctorate Program Grant**. The **Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan** is available also. Entrance Loan Counseling and completion of the Master Promissory Note is a requirement to receive federal loans and may be completed electronically at studentaid.gov. The Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan limit for graduate students is \$20,500 for the academic year. If additional aid is needed, graduate students have the option to apply for a **Federal Graduate PLUS Loan**. **Graduate students must be enrolled at least half-time (4 units, 500 level courses) to receive financial aid and to defer prior student loans.**

CSU Employee Fee Waiver: Please check with UP (University Personnel) or your campus HR to see how much of a fee waiver you could qualify for and to start the process for the waiver if interested.

Third Party Payments (VA Benefits, Dept of Rehab, Employee Reimbursement); Please check with the agency providing the funds to see what is required and then work with the Bursar’s Office.

Payment plan options are available from the Bursar’s Office and can be viewed at <http://www.sjsu.edu/bursar/>. Financial Aid applicants may be eligible to delay their fee payment due date if your financial aid file is complete and you are awaiting financial aid funds. Once the Financial Aid Office verifies enrollment, tuition and other fees will be deducted from financial aid awards and any remaining funds will be sent to the student.
