

## Washington D.C. Internship Opportunities

Students interested in public service are encouraged to apply to intern at Senator Schiff's Washington, D.C. office.

### Who is Eligible

- 18+
- Current college students or recent graduates
- Be a U.S. citizen, or
  - Be lawfully admitted for permanent residence and seeking citizenship as outlined in 8 U.S.C. § 1324b(a)(3)(B)
  - Or be (i) admitted as a refugee under 8 U.S.C. § 1157 or granted asylum under 8 U.S.C. § 1158 and (ii) have filed a declaration of intention to become a lawful permanent resident and then a citizen when eligible
  - Or Owe allegiance to the U.S. (i.e., qualify as a non-citizen U.S. national under federal law)

### Responsibilities

- Help constituents navigate issues with federal agencies
- Draft constituent correspondence
- Research and respond to constituent inquiries
- Welcome guests to the office
- Attend hearings
- Assist with tours
- Work with the Washington D.C. and California teams

This internship is in-person and offers a monthly stipend.
