Teach For America Corps

A two-year, full-time teaching role for graduating seniors, graduate students, and early-career professionals from any major — no education background or prior teaching experience required.

- Lead your own classroom in an under-resourced public school — with real responsibility from day one
- Earn a full salary and benefits through your school district: \$32,000–\$72,000 depending on region
- Receive a \$3,000–\$6,500 stipend for summer training and transition costs, plus additional need-based grants and interest-free loans
- Build communication, problem-solving, and adaptability skills that transfer into any field — through work that actually required them
- Learn how schools connect to issues like college access, housing, and public health — from the inside
- Join a national network of more than 70,000 TFA alumni working across education, law, healthcare, tech, policy, and more



Teach For America Ignite

A paid, part-time virtual tutoring opportunity for college students in any year or major — no tutoring or teaching experience required.

- Tutor K–12 students during the school day — when learning impact is highest and your evenings stay yours
- Earn \$1,000 per semester, paid at the end of each semester
- Build practical skills in communication, facilitation, adaptability, and planning — through sessions that are structured and supported, not improvised
- Every session comes with a lesson plan — your job is to deliver it well, not design curriculum from scratch
- Explore whether education or another purpose-driven path could be part of your future — without a long-term commitment
