Since there will be one less 'Assignment' and one more 'Exam' than originally planned, the grading will be modified as follows. In all, there will now be four exams (Exam 1, 2, 3 and 4), the Final Exam, and three assignments (Assignments 1, 2 and 3). So there will be a total of eight scored coursework items in the class. The final course grade will be calculated by assigning the following percentage weights to the individual scores on your coursework:

- Assignments 1 and 2: $10 \%$ each ( $=20 \%$ total)
- Assignment 3: 12.5\%
- Highest scoring exam: 20\%
- Lowest scoring exams: $10 \%$
- Remaining two exams \& Final Exam: 12.5\% each ( $=37.5 \%$ total)
(Adding these up, you get $20 \%+12.5 \%+20 \%+10 \%+37.5 \%=100 \%$ )
After adding up the scores on all exams and assignments weighted according to the above percentages, letter grades will then be assigned as follows: $85-100=\mathrm{A} ; 70-85=\mathrm{B} ; 60$ - $70=\mathrm{C} ; 50-60$ =D; below $50=\mathrm{F}$. A +/ - grading system will be used for final grades.
