Purpose: The purpose is to encourage alumni to remain connected with the College of Social Sciences and to recognize those making an important contribution to the College. An engraved plaque will be formally presented to the recipient at the College of Social Sciences Awards Ceremony in April.

Eligibility:

- Recipients should have completed a degree program that has been offered by one of the departments of the college. They will have:
 - made an outstanding contribution to the college, and
 - made outstanding professional or civic contributions in venues outside the college.

These two criteria will be given equal weight in the selection of candidates. Special consideration will be given to candidates for this award whose SJSU education seemed to be particularly important in leading to important achievement, as in the case of alumni who have had to overcome considerable adversity to make their mark in the world.

Nomination Materials:

- Letter of nomination summarizing the nominee's distinguished accomplishments. Nominations are made by the College of Social Sciences Department Chairs and Dean.

Selection Process: The Dean will select the awardee in consultation with the College development director.
