The California Dream Act Application (CADAA) grants state and school financial aid to undocumented students who qualify for AB 540, AB 2000, or SB 68 (also known as the CA Non Resident Tuition Exemption).

5 Things to know

- You DO NOT need a SSN
- DACA ≠ CA Dream Act
- AB 540 is a gateway to financial aid
- Accepting state/university aid WILL NOT affect your immigration status;
- All information and data shared in the application is protected.

Who can apply?

Undergraduate AND graduate undocumented students who meet the requirement for the CA Non-Resident Tuition Exemption.

This includes students who have/are:

- Undocumented, without a SSN
- DACA
- TPS
- U or T Visa
