

What is the difference between in-state and out of state tuition?

In-State Tuition Cost (2022-23)			
Total for the Academic Year		Cost Per Semester (Fall)	
Part Time (1.0-6.0 units)	Full Time (6.1 or more units)	Part Time (1.0-6.0 units)	Full Time (6.1 or more units)
\$5,463*	\$7,905.50	\$2,743	\$3,926

Note: **Fall** and **Spring** rates will be slightly different.

Example of Non-California Resident Tuition Cost for ONE SEMESTER			
# of Units	Regular Tuition & Fees Cost	Out of State Fee (\$396/ unit)	Total Cost for the Semester
12 Units (full time)	\$3,926	\$396 x 12 units = \$4752	\$8,678
6 units (part time)	\$2,743	\$396 x 6 units = \$2,376	\$5,119

Non-California Resident Students: Pay the in-state tuition amount **plus \$396 per unit.**

The amounts that appear on the charts reflect the cost of tuition and mandatory student fees. The cost of living and other student expenses are not calculated here.
